UCSB CLASSES

- Exam P
 - PSTAT 120A and a small portion of PSTAT 120B
 - Classes cover 90% of the exam syllabus
- Exam FM
 - PSTAT 171 and a small portion of PSTAT 170
 - Classes cover 90% of exam syllabus

UCSB CLASSES

- Exam MFE
 - PSTAT 170 and PSTAT 176
 - Classes cover 90% of the exam syllabus
- Exam MLC
 - PSTAT 172A and PSTAT 172B
 - Classes cover 80% of the exam syllabus
- Exam C
 - PSTAT 173
 - Class covers 60% of the exam syllabus

HOW CLASSES AND EXAMS RELATE

- Take class before studying for exam
 - Most common way
 - Gives good understanding of the material
 - Great way to start studying for an exam
- Take class while studying for exam
 - Most beneficial for both exam and class
 - Time consuming
- Take class after studying for exam
 - Hardest way
 - A lot of self studying
 - Easy to get a good grade in the class

STUDY MANUALS

- ASM, ACTEX, Adapt, The Infinite Actuary
- Great way to learn the material and get introduced to it
- Learn and review the material
- Resources include practice exams
- Companies pay for study materials

 - Practice exams, study manual, video lessons
 - Subscription based
 - Exams that cater to your understanding
 - Large question bank

CALCULATORS

- TI-30XS (\$15)
 - Multi-line Display
 - Basic statistical functions (Data Tables, Finding Mean, Variance, etc.)
- BA II Plus (\$35)
 - Single-line Display
 - Financial Commands (Annuities, bonds) very useful for Exam FM



STUDY TIPS

- Allot 100 hours per exam hour
 - Example: Exam P is 3 hours, so you should study for 300 hours
- Create a study schedule for yourself
 - Excel file that records how many pages you have gone through and how many pages are left
- Dedicate 1/3 of study time to review problems/practice exams
 - Last month before exam


STUDY TIPS

- Memorize formulas
 - Note cards, Note sheet
 - Memorize important formulas where you can derive other formulas
- Focus on materials you aren't comfortable with

PERSONAL TAKE ON EXAMS

CHANGES TO THE SOA TRACK

- VEE Applied Statistics is replaced with VEE Mathematical Statistics
- Addition of accounting to the Corporate Finance VEE
- Addition of pricing and reserving of short-term insurances to Exam C
- Less emphasis on derivatives and more on investment in the Investment and Financial Markets exam
- Addition of an exam on the basics of applied statistics (Statistics for Risk Modeling)
- Addition of an exam on predictive analytics
